



Things that may be helpful to share with families when recruiting families for Cookie Day

Once potential participants understand that the day is to educate elected officials about the need for more housing (MRVP) many of them will want to join the efforts to advocate at the event!!!

- Cookie Day is a day of action; it's an opportunity for families to take action in order to address housing inaccessibility and shortage.
- They get to visit with elected officials (to drop off cookies or a post card, which they will have an opportunity to fill out asking for what they need most - housing).
- There will be families who have experienced homelessness on our speaking agenda.
- Children are welcomed. Although there is no childcare, they can absolutely be part of the day!
- When they arrive they will be greeted, registered and seated by our team of families who have experienced homelessness.
- Cookie Day is about families... Don't let people make decisions about family without your input.
